Culvert C057052 Replacement

The County of Simcoe has awarded the Culvert C057052 Replacement Contract, located on Oro Line 3N, in the Township of Oro-Medonte to Dufferin Construction Company (Dufferin).

Dufferin is scheduled to begin construction activities for the Replacement of Culvert C057052 on **July 2, 2024**. Replacement of Culvert C057052 is scheduled for completion by **October 31, 2024**. Oro Line 3N will remain closed, between Highway 11 and Ski Trails Road, for the duration of the Culvert Replacement Works. The Works consists of:

- Mobilization and site preparation;
- Traffic control and Road Closure;
- Installation of sediment control measures;
- Removal of asphalt;
- Removal of existing culvert;
- Installation of new precast concrete culvert;
- Construction of distribution slab;
- Waterproofing;
- Construction of MSE retaining wall;
- Removal and replacement of driveway culverts;
- Roadway construction including asphalt placement and line painting;
- Installation of guide rail; and
- Site restoration and demobilization.

Road Closure / Detour Route

During Culvert Replacement operations, Line 3 North will be closed throughout the duration of the Contract between Highway 11 and Ski Trails Road. Two designated Detour Routes shall be place. 1) Highway 11 West, Golf Course Road (Line 2N) and Ski Trails Road. 2) Ski Trails Road, County Road 93 and Highway 11 East. Local access will be maintained throughout the Road Closure.

We ask that extra precautions be taken and that you observe all detour and advisory signage during the Culvert Replacement activities. We also appreciate your continued patience during this vital improvement to the County of Simcoe transportation network.

How Will I Get to My Home / Business?

The Contractor will maintain access to your home / business. On occasion, however, direct access to Line 3N may be interrupted due to large equipment entering and exiting the site.

Access will be restored as quickly as possible after the work is completed, and the equipment has been removed. The Contractor will give prior notice of any access restrictions to the residents.

Pedestrian access to homes and businesses will be maintained during construction.

If you have any special needs for wheelchair access, please advise the R.J. Burnside Site Inspector (Trevor Littlejohns).

Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.

Will My Services Be Affected?

Telephone, Electrical, Cable TV and gas services should not be affected by the construction, barring any unforeseen circumstances.

Safety

Construction involves the use of heavy equipment and the unavoidable creation of obstacles.

These circumstances are often attractive to children, we ask that you caution your children to stay clear of the working area.

We ask that you take extra caution during the construction period to ensure everyone's safety.
